## Neighborhood Directory Update

We're finally making it happen! Your Green Acres civic association is hard at work on revising the neighborhood directory, last published in 2020. (Your district rep may be reaching out to verify contact information for your

household.) The directory is a handy printed resource for getting in touch with folks in the neighborhood – to ask questions, extend invitations, swap misdelivered parcels, or just put a name to a face. It also contains evergreen information about the history of the development and other Green Acres lore. Look for the directories to be delivered later this year!

#### **Tax Relief for Seniors**

The March newsletter of NCCo District 2 Councilwoman Dee Durham contained information about two programs we thought were worth passing along for the benefit of our older neighbors.

### School Property Tax Relief

Homeowners age 65 or over are eligible for a tax credit against regular school property taxes of 50 percent (up to \$500). This credit may only be used against property taxes on a primary residence.

Ten-year Residency Requirement for New Applicants:

• Individuals who establish legal domicile in Delaware on or after January 1, 2018 will be required to have been legally domiciled within the State for a period of at least 10 consecutive years in order to be eligible to receive a credit. Individuals who establish legal domicile in Delaware AFTER December 31, 2012, but prior to January 1, 2018 will continue to be required to have been legally domiciled within the State for a period of at least 3 consecutive years in order to be eligible to receive a credit. Individuals who have established domicile in Delaware prior to January 1, 2013, will be eligible to receive the credit in the ensuing tax year.

#### Please Note:

- Taxpayers must pay their property tax bill in full by the end of each tax year in order to qualify for this credit for the subsequent property tax year.
- Application Deadline: April 30th.
- To qualify, a copy of a valid driver's license or official state ID is required for each applicant at the time of application.

## New Castle County Senior Property Tax Exemption (Deadline: June 1st)

- Applicant must be at least 65 years of age prior to July 1 of the fiscal year for which the exemption is sought.
- Applicant must own the property.
- The property must be the applicant's principal residence.
- Applicant's income must not exceed \$50,000 per year.
- The assessed value of the property does not exceed \$125,000.
- Applicant must have been legally domiciled within the State of Delaware for a period of ten consecutive years immediately preceding October 1 of the pretax year.
- Property must have all taxes and sewer service charges paid in full, or the applicant must be actively enrolled and making monthly payments of any and all tax and sewer services charges due and collectible.
- Property must continue one of these options to keep the exemption from year to year.

Receive a reduction of the taxable assessed value of \$32,000. This exemption is exclusive of any local light—and ditch taxes.
